Through partnerships with local stakeholders, UIUCares ensures training is tailored to local economic needs, enabling participants to thrive in competitive markets. The initiative addresses systemic barriers to economic participation by providing technical skills, business acumen, and market entry guidance, with a focus on empowering participants to achieve self reliance and contribute to community development. 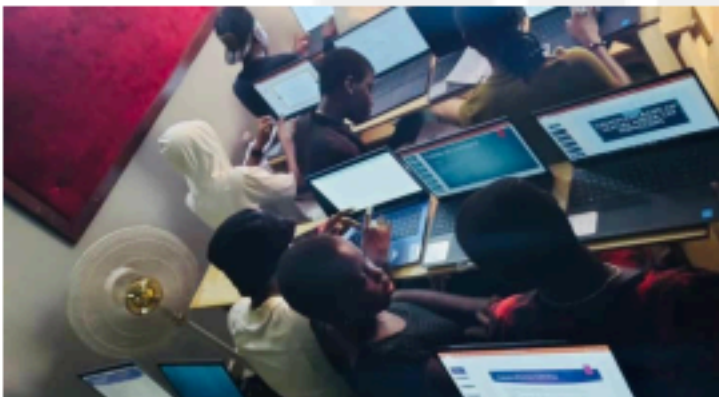
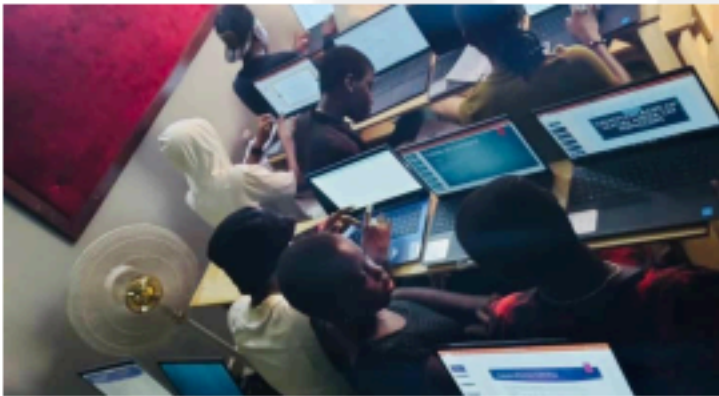


UMU IGBO UNITE CARES TECHNOLOGY AND DIGITAL LITERACY PROGRAM

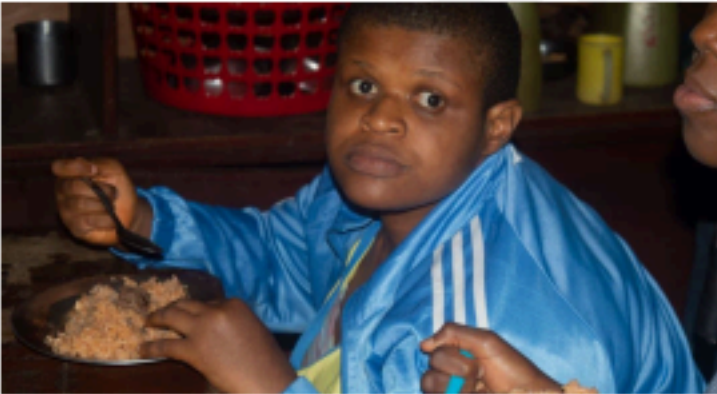
UMU IGBO UNITE CARES COMMUNITY RELIEF AND SOCIAL INCLUSION PROGRAM
